

### Why liberal arts at MTSU?

### **Advising**

CLA believes competent and caring advisors are an essential part of a college student's academic success, and we are committed to excellence in all advising processes. As a CLA student, you will be assigned two advisors—one college advisor and one faculty member.

### **College Advisors**

- are degree requirement specialists and assist in creating a program of study to complete requirements in a timely and manageable fashion
- follow your progress each semester and can recommend support services for overcoming challenges or offer advice for navigating University processes

### **Faculty Advisors**

- are experts in their disciplines and serve as mentors to help you understand and excel in your field
- assist with selecting electives or minors to complement career interests
- provide guidance regarding internship or study abroad opportunities, strengthening resumes and portfolios, and other activities that enhance readiness for graduate school or a profession

Working together with you, this advising team helps you to reach your goals and position yourself for success!

### Cocurricular Engagement

Getting involved in cocurricular activities enriches your experience on campus. It can create a sense of belonging and connectedness and enhance academic success, mental health, and career readiness. From taking the field with our Band of Blue to competing with Model United Nations to conducting undergraduate research, CLA offers a variety of cocurricular opportunities for you. You can also join specific clubs for your major(s), community engagement groups, and academic honor societies. Whatever your interests, opportunities abound for you in CLA.

Annually, CLA offers short-term study abroad programs led by our faculty, along with semester/yearlong international exchanges. CLA provides financial support for unpaid internships and study abroad scholarships because we know that immersive learning leads to life-changing experiences.





### Liberal Arts Mentoring Program

As a CLA student, you can sign up for the Liberal Arts Mentoring Program (LAMP) during your first year at MTSU. In LAMP, new students (mentees) are paired with more experienced students (mentors) based on similar majors, backgrounds, or interests. Mentees receive encouragement and information about University resources from mentors to help keep them on track for success. Most importantly, mentees can draw from mentors' experiences about how to succeed in coursework, get involved on campus, and prepare for their future careers.
